Car Scheme Drivers

Drivers use their own car to provide essential door-to-door transport for passengers who have registered with us.

You could be asked to help passengers into or out of the car and are expected to wait with those attending a medical appointment, for up to an hour.

Put your driving skills to good use and we will pay up to 40p a mile.

We are looking for drivers over 25 with a full licence and no more than six penalty points.

Minibus Drivers

Beverley Community Lift operates shopper services to various East Riding towns and day trips for its clients to places like York, the coast or other popular destinations.

We urgently need more drivers in both Beverley and Pocklington - no minibus experience is necessary as full training will be given.

Volunteers need to be 25 or over and have a D1 driving licence.

Passenger Assistants

Our minibus drivers often enjoy the support of a volunteer to help with journeys and looking after our passengers. We run regular shopper services and day trips so it is up to you how much time you can give. The role may involve assisting customers with wheelchairs and handling money.
